A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to education; to require a public K-12 school or a local board of education to accept certain forms of payment for admission to certain school-sponsored events.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. A public K-12 school or a local board of education shall accept all forms of payment, including cash, for admission to school-sponsored sporting events that are open to the public.

1 Section 2. This act shall become effective
2 immediately following its passage and approval by the
3 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
