Section 2. This act is curative and shall apply 6 retroactively to confirm the continued existence and 7 continuing authority of the Alabama Commission on Tick Borne 8 Illness to allocate funds for research on tick borne illness 9 10 in the state. Section 3. This act shall become effective on the 11 12 first day of the third month following its passage and

approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
