SYNOPSIS: In 2016, the Legislature created the Alabama Commission on Tick Borne Illness, now codified as Chapter 11C of Title 22, Code of Alabama 1975. The act creating the commission provided that the commission shall dissolve on September 30, 2021, unless continued by act of the Legislature.

This bill would extend the existence of the commission until September 30, 2025, and would provide for retroactive application.

TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

Relating to the Alabama Commission on Tick Borne Illness; to amend Section 5 of Act 2016-356 of the 2016 Regular Session, (Acts 2016, p. 881), by extending the existence of the commission; and to provide retroactive application.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1                   Section 1. Section 5 of Act 2016-356 of the 2016  
2 Regular Session, (Acts 2016, p. 881), is amended to read as  
3 follows:

4                   The commission shall dissolve on September 30, ~~2021~~  
5 2025, unless continued by act of the Legislature.

6                   Section 2. This act is curative and shall apply  
7 retroactively to confirm the continued existence and  
8 continuing authority of the Alabama Commission on Tick Borne  
9 Illness to allocate funds for research on tick borne illness  
10 in the state.

11                   Section 3. This act shall become effective on the  
12 first day of the third month following its passage and  
13 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
