20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
21	Section 1. During the 180 day period immediately
22	after an inmate is released from custody, he or she shall not
23	be required to pay any outstanding court-assessed fines, fees,
24	or costs. This section shall not apply to any supervision fees
25	assessed as a condition of release from custody.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
first day of the third month following its passage and
approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
