A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to Conecuh County; to provide further for the selection of the chair of the county commission for the remainder of the current term of the chair of the county commission; to provide for an additional expense allowance for the chair of the county commission for the remainder of the current term; and to provide for the repeal of this act effective at the end of the current term of the chair of the county commission.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. This act shall only apply in Conecuh county.

Section 2. Effective after the first day of the month following the effective date of this act, the county commission shall select the chair of the county commission by majority vote of the members of the county commission to serve

1 for the remainder of the term of the county commission as
2 provided by law.

3 Section 3. Effective on the first day of the month
4 following the effective date of this act, the chair of the
5 county commission shall receive an expense allowance of seven
6 hundred fifty dollars (\$750) per month. The expense allowance
7 provided in this section shall be payable out of the general
8 fund of the county and shall be in addition to any salary
9 provided to the chair of the county commission by law. This
10 expense allowance shall expire at the end of the current term
11 of the county commission.

12 Section 4. All laws or parts of laws in conflict
13 with this act are repealed and superseded until the end of the
14 current term of the chair of the county commission.

15 Section 5. This act shall be repealed upon the end
16 of the current term of the county commission and shall have no
17 further effect.

18 Section 6. This act shall become effective
19 immediately following its passage and approval by the
20 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
