21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
22	Section 1. This act shall only apply in Conecuh
23	county.
24	Section 2. Effective after the first day of the
25	month following the effective date of this act, the county
26	commission shall select the chair of the county commission by
27	majority vote of the members of the county commission to serve

for the remainder of the term of the county commission as provided by law.

Section 3. Effective on the first day of the month following the effective date of this act, the chair of the county commission shall receive an expense allowance of seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750) per month. The expense allowance provided in this section shall be payable out of the general fund of the county and shall be in addition to any salary provided to the chair of the county commission by law. This expense allowance shall expire at the end of the current term of the county commission.

Section 4. All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this act are repealed and superseded until the end of the current term of the chair of the county commission.

Section 5. This act shall be repealed upon the end of the current term of the county commission and shall have no further effect.

Section 6. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
