3 CELEBRATING THE LIFE OF MRS. ANNE GRIGGS ROBERTS.

5 WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow that we note the  
6 death on March 4, 2022, of Mrs. Anne Griggs Roberts at the age  
7 of 64; and

8 WHEREAS, her passing leaves a void in the lives of  
9 her loving family, many friends, and the entire community,  
10 where she was highly regarded; and

11 WHEREAS, Mrs. Roberts was born in Dalton, Georgia,  
12 to Carl L. Griggs, Sr. and Charlotte J. Griggs; and

13 WHEREAS, upon graduating from Dalton High School,  
14 Mrs. Roberts attended Auburn University, where she majored in  
15 accounting; she enjoyed the many friendships that she made  
16 during her time as an Alpha Delta Pi, where she also served as  
17 Sorority President; and

18 WHEREAS, in December 1980, Mrs. Roberts married her  
19 college sweetheart, Dan Roberts; during their early years of  
20 marriage, they lived in Montgomery, South Korea, Saudi Arabia,  
21 and Atlanta before settling down in Birmingham, Alabama, where  
22 they reared their three boys, David, Steven, and Andrew; one  
23 of Mrs. Roberts' greatest joys was being involved in her sons'  
24 lives; she enjoyed homeschooling her sons, and also teaching  
25 Vacation Bible School and serving as a Little League team mom,

1 during the year that she and her family served with Campus  
2 Outreach in Belo Horizonte, Brazil; furthermore, the Lord used

9 her relationships with her precious grandchildren; her clever

11 who knew and loved her; content with her relationship with the  
12 Lord, she daily lived by her motto, "Jesus is enough"; and

13 WHEREAS, she was preceded in death by her father;

15 WHEREAS, Mrs. Roberts is survived by our good friend  
16 and colleague, her loving husband of 41 years, Senator Dan  
17 Roberts; mother; sons, David Roberts (Chelsea), Steven  
18 Roberts, and Andrew Roberts (Linley); grandchildren, Charlotte  
19 Anne, Chandler, Caroline, Collier, Reese, Bennett, Emmy, and  
20 baby Boone, who is expected in April 2022; brothers, Carl
