7 Freedom's Sentinel, and Noble Eagle, flying over 220 combat
8 and combat support sorties in the KC-135; also, he is a Flying
9 Safety Officer, an Aircraft Mishap Investigator, and the
10 Safety and Accident Investigation Board President; a highly
11 decorated pilot, Colonel Etheredge has accumulated more than
12 5,100 flying hours; and
