27 by a small team of employees and a network of volunteers; it

has developed statewide safety and educational initiatives,
 more than 200 river-front campsites, and with grant funds,
 erected more than 200 informational signs on waterways across
 the state; and

5 WHEREAS, to further the goals of the Alabama Scenic 6 River Trail, the Great Alabama 650 adventure race was 7 inaugurated in 2019 along the original 650-mile section of the 8 ASRT drawing international attention, including over 1,000,000 9 "impressions" from news stories and social media posts; and

10 WHEREAS, the race was held for a third year in 2021; 11 and

12 WHEREAS, winners in the race and their winning times 13 were: Two-Person team, Joe Mann from Kansas City, Missouri, 14 and Paul Cox from Atlanta, Georgia, 4 days, 2 hours, and 17 15 minutes; Male solo, West Hansen from Austin, Texas, 5 days, 19 16 hours, and 9 minutes; and Female solo, Salli O'Donnell from 17 Fort Walton Beach, Florida, 4 days, 22 hours, and 39 minutes; 18 and

WHEREAS, this body recognizes the skill,
perseverance, and mental and physical toughness of all
participants, and particularly of the division winners; now
