8 MOURNING THE DEATH OF MR. CHARLES CLINTON ROSECRANS.

10 WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow that we note the
11 death on February 21, 2022, of Mr. Charles Clinton "Chuck"
12 Rosecrans at the age of 76; and

13 WHEREAS, his passing leaves a void in the lives of
14 his loving family, many friends, and the entire community,
15 where he was highly regarded; and

16 WHEREAS, Mr. Rosecrans was born on May 9, 1945, to
17 Reverend C. Wayne Rosecrans and Lois Harlin Rosecrans Bolin in
18 North Kansas City, Missouri; after graduating from high
19 school, Mr. Rosecrans earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree in
20 Sociology and a Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing from
21 William Jewell College in Liberty, Missouri; he earned a
22 Master's Degree in Management from Webster University in St.
23 Louis, Missouri; at the age of 24 he enlisted in the U.S.
24 Army, and then spent 24 years as an officer in the U.S. Navy;
25 after retiring from the U.S. Navy, Mr. Rosecrans continued his
26 career at Lake City Medical Center in Lake City, Florida,

1 Crestwood Medical Center in Huntsville, Alabama, and Madison
2 Surgery Center in Madison, Alabama; and

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Rosecrans was an active member, deacon,
4 and choir member of First Baptist Church Huntsville; involved
5 in choral music all of his life, he also sang with the Newport
6 Navy Choristers while stationed in Rhode Island; in recent
7 years he was member of the Huntsville Community Chorus; he
8 enjoyed traveling, especially to historical battlefields; one
9 of his most memorable trips was to the beaches of Normandy,
10 France; an avid sports enthusiast, he loved baseball of any
11 kind, college football, especially the alma maters of his
12 children, the University of Georgia and Texas A and M, and the
13 NFL, supporting the Kansas City Chiefs; and

14 WHEREAS, he was preceded in death by his parents and
15 stepfather Raymond Bolin; he is survived by his wife of 52
16 years, Connie Allee Rosecrans; daughter, Dr. Shay Rosecrans
17 (Dr. Jerome Enad); son, C. Trent Rosecrans (Michelle); two
18 beloved granddaughters, Allee McDonald and Lucinda Rosecrans;
19 sister, Karen Orlando (Phillip); nine sisters-in-law; nine
20 brothers-in-law; 26 nephews and nieces; and a host of other
21 relatives and many friends; and

22 WHEREAS, although his presence will be greatly
23 missed, the memory of Mr. Rosecrans will be cherished in the
24 hearts of all who knew and loved him; now therefore,

25 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
26 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That the death of Mr. Charles
27 Clinton "Chuck" Rosecrans is recorded with deep sadness, and
