11	WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow that we note the
12	death on January 22, 2022, of Greene County Commissioner for
13	District One, Mr. Lester "Bop" Brown at the age of 61; and
14	WHEREAS, his passing leaves a void in the lives of

17	WHEREAS, Mr. Brown was born on March 23, 1960, and
18	served in the United States Army and the Army National Guard;
19	after serving several terms with the Greene County Board of

22	term as Greene County Commissioner and planning to run for
23	re-election; Mr. Brown passionately worked closely with the

WHEREAS, Mr. Brown is survived by his wife, Linette and five children; although his presence will be greatly missed, the memory of Mr. Brown will be cherished in the hearts of all who knew and loved him; now therefore,
