2 Staff, G-4, United States Forces Command; Director for the
3 Strategy and Integration Directorate, G-4/5/7; Executive
4 Officer to the Army Materiel Command Deputy Commanding
5 General; and Commander of the 225th Forward Support Battalion
6 and Division G-4, 25th Infantry Division; and

8 support of Operation Iraqi Freedom, Operation Iraqi Freedom
9 II, Operation New Dawn, Operation Enduring Freedom, and
10 Operation Resolute Support; he was commissioned as a Second
11 Lieutenant in the Quartermaster Corps upon his graduation from
12 Auburn University in 1987; he earned Master's Degrees in
13 Logistics Management from the Florida Institute of Technology
14 and in Military Arts and Sciences from the United States Army
15 War College; and

17 Distinguished Service Medal, Legion of Merit with four Oak
18 Leaf Clusters, Bronze Star Medal with two Oak Leaf Clusters,
