23	Relating to the Alabama State Board of Veterinary
24	Examiners; to amend Section 34-29-67, Code of Alabama 1975, to
25	increase the daily stipend for board members; and to authorize
26	the board to increase the amount of the daily stipend by rule.
27	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 34-29-67, Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

3 "\$34-29-67.

"(a) The members of the board shall receive two six hundred dollars (\$200) (\$600) a day for each day, or a portion thereof, the member is actually engaged in the work of the board, and in addition, the usual per diem expenses allowed to other persons acting in the service of the State of Alabama or any of its agencies, institutions, boards, bureaus, or commissions. The board, by rule, may increase the compensation of its members, as necessary, including, but not limited to, the payment of relief veterinarians, while the members are engaged in the work of the board.

"(b) The legal expenses of the board for administration of this article shall be paid from funds in the State Treasury to the credit of the board and shall be paid only on warrant of the State Treasurer and approved by the Governor. No funds shall be withdrawn or expended except as budgeted and allotted pursuant to Title 41, Chapter 4, Article 4, and only in amounts as stipulated in the general appropriations act."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
