SYNOPSIS: Existing law sets out the maximum number of days a member of a board of registrars may work on an annual basis, depending on the county.

This bill would authorize the quorum of a board of registrars, upon consent of the county commission, to reallocate unused days from one registrar to another registrar, in cases of absence, in order to accomplish the business of the board.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to boards of registrars; to add Section 17-3-8.1, to the Code of Alabama 1975, to provide further for the number of days a registrar may annually work.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 17-3-8.1 is added to the Code of Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

1 §17-3-8.1.

2 Upon receiving the written consent and approval of
3 the county commission and consistent with the annual maximum
4 number of working days authorized under Section 17-3-8, a
5 quorum of a board of registrars of a county may reallocate
6 unused working days from one registrar due to absence to
7 another registrar of that board in order to accomplish the
8 public business of the board. Written consent by the county
9 commission must be granted for each pay period during which a
10 registrar submits a request to use another registrar's working
11 days.

12 Section 2. This act shall become effective
13 immediately following its passage and approval by the
14 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
