23	Section 1. Section 15-3-2, Code of Alabama 1975, is
24	amended to read as follows:

26	"Unless otherwise (a) Except as provided in
27	subsection (b), the prosecution of all misdemeanors before a

1	circuit or district court <u>must</u> <u>shall</u> be commenced within 12
2	months after the commission of the offense.
3	"(b) The period of limitation shall be tolled during
4	any period of time an offender is participating in a
5	court-approved drug rehabilitation program or a court-approved
6	diversion program."
7	Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
8	first day of the third month following its passage and
9	approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
