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11 Relating to motor vehicle registration receipt forms
12 and validation decals; to add Section 32-6-64.2 to the Code of
13 Alabama 1975; to allow a county licensing official to contract
14 with a third party, upon approval of the county commission, to
15 provide materials for print-on-demand validation decals,
16 emblems, and registration receipt forms; to provide that
17 amounts distributed to the Department of Corrections shall not
18 be reduced by such contracts; and to provide that such
19 contracts are subject to the procurement provisions of the
20 county.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

22 Section 1. Section 32-6-64.2 is added to the Code of
23 Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

24 §32-6-64.2.

25 (a) In lieu of being supplied validation decals,
26 emblems, and registration receipt forms directly from the
27 Department of Corrections or the Department of Revenue, county

1 licensing officials may contract with a third party, upon
2 approval by the county commission, to provide materials for
3 print-on-demand validation decals, emblems, and registration
4 receipt forms. The validation decals, emblems, and
5 registration receipt forms shall be subject to review and
6 approval by the Department of Revenue to ensure statewide
7 uniformity.

8 (b) The amount distributed to the Department of
9 Corrections pursuant to this chapter, including Section
10 32-6-64.1, or any other provision of law, shall not be reduced
11 by any contract entered into by a county licensing official
12 pursuant to this section, nor shall any contract entered into
13 pursuant to this section be interpreted to apply to or extend
14 to registrations issued under Chapter 5 of Title 33.

15 (c) Contracts entered into pursuant to this section
16 shall be subject to the procurement requirements of the
17 licensing official's county.

18 (d) The Department of Revenue may adopt rules for
19 the implementation and administration of this section.

20 Section 2. This act shall become effective
21 immediately following its passage and approval by the
22 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
