26	WHEREAS, in 2017, Tom Walker was one of only sixteen
27	citizens appointed by Congressional leaders to the United

States Semiquincentennial Commission; the commission is responsible for leading the Nation's 250th birthday celebration and commemoration of American Independence in 2026; he was unanimously elected as Vice Chair of the national commission at its first meeting in Philadelphia; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Walker earned his Bachelor of Arts

Degree with honors in History and Political Science at the

University of Montevallo and his Master of Arts in Political

Science at Mississippi State University; and

WHEREAS, in December 2020, Mr. Walker was conferred the Honorary Doctor of Laws by Troy University; he has received numerous other honors; he is a past recipient of the American Bar Association's highest national award for excellence in K-12 law-related education; he is the recipient of the DAR Medal of Honor and the SAR Gold Citizenship Medal, the highest national honors awarded by the National Societies of the Daughters of the American Revolution and of the Sons of the American Revolution, respectively; he has received numerous other state, regional, and national awards and was named as "Birmingham Citizen of the Year" by The Women's Committee of Birmingham; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Walker is the former City Manager of Northport, Alabama, and formerly served as Special Assistant to the President of the University of Montevallo; he is the former Vice Chair of the Board of Trustees of the University of Montevallo and was the founding chair of the Alabama Higher Education Partnership; Mr. Walker is both a writer and
