Alabama 1975, or anyone assembling bid documents, whether as an employee or a contractor or consultant, a conflict of interest exists if the individual is also employed by, or contractor to, a vendor for any materials, products, or other

25 tangible property used for or to be incorporated into the

26 design of that public contract for building construction.

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(b) A violation of this section is a violation of the Ethics Law, Chapter 25 of Title 36, Code of Alabama 1975.



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Section 2. Although this bill would have as its purpose 29 30 or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further requirements 31 32 and application under Section 111.05 of the Constitution of 33 Alabama of 2022, because the bill defines a new crime or 34 amends the definition of an existing crime. Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first 35 36 day of the third month following its passage and approval by 37 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
