SYNOPSIS:

A BILL
TO BE ENACTED
AN ACT

Relating to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board; to add Section 28-3A-6.1 to the Code of Alabama 1975, to authorize a licensed manufacturer or importer of alcoholic beverages to donate a limited amount of alcoholic beverages to a licensed nonprofit special event.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 28-3A-6.1 is added to the Code of Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

§28-3A-6.1

A licensed manufacturer or importer in this state, or its agent, may donate and deliver up to 4.5 liters or equivalent thereof of liquor sourced from a licensed manufacturer or importer to a licensed nonprofit special event operated by or on behalf of a nonprofit organization for each event. Donations shall be taxed in accordance with state and federal laws, rules, and regulations. Donations shall be reported on a form prescribed by the board. ~~Donations shall be taxed on a sales price imputed by~~ A licensed manufacturer or importer, or its agent, shall acquire the product from the board based upon the listed retail price of the product

29 donated. Any liquor remaining at the conclusion of the
30 nonprofit event shall be returned to the broker for disposal.

31 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first
32 day of the third month following its passage and approval by
33 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
