Senate Bill 197 as reported by the Committee on State Governmental Affairs, could increase obligations of State agencies, boards, departments, or commissions beginning a new program or newly instituted public benefit: (1) to consult with the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts on the availability of benefit payments, fraud prevention and detection systems; and (2) to implement any service or system if identified as available for integration modification, or replacement of an existing system.

In addition, this bill would increase the administrative obligations of the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts to provide consultations pursuant to the provisions of this bill.
