Senate Bill 220 as reported by the Committee on State Governmental Affairs could increase or decrease the obligations of the State Employees' Health Insurance Plan (SEHIP) and the Public Education Employees' Health Insurance Plan (PEEHIP) by an undetermined amount dependent upon the difference in the cost of alternative medications recommended by a pharmacist when the acquisition cost for the pharmacy or pharmacist for a specific medication is below or above what the pharmacy benefits manager reimburses.
