## Senate Bill 57

Senate Bill 57 as introduced will establish the Alabama Loan Repayment Program for Nursing Education students who agree to work in a prelicense nursing education program in the state for 2 years. The loans will be administered by the Alabama Board of Nursing and funded by direct appropriation from the Education Trust Fund. The Board may award three year scholarships for recipients pursuing a master degree and four year scholarships for recipients pursuing a doctorate degree. First year annual loan amounts may not exceed \$15,000 but may be increased annually by no more than 5% in years 2-3 for recipients pursing a master's degree and years 2-4 for recipients pursing a doctorate degree. This bill also provides for the repayment of the nursing education loans and penalties for non-fulfillment of loan contracts.

This bill will increase the administrative obligations of the Board by an undetermined amount for (1) the administration of the loan repayment program; (2) to adopt reasonable rules to implement and administer the program; and (3) to report annually on the condition and accomplishments of the program.
