Senate Bill 89 as introduced would authorize the Alabama Law Enforcement Agency (ALEA) to issue and renew an 8-year driver license at a cost of \$91.75 per license which would, for every 8-year license issued or renewed: (1) increase receipts by \$53.50 to the State General Fund to be appropriated for public safety use as required under existing law and; (2) decrease receipts to the Public Safety Fund by \$5.

This bill would also increase the current 4-year driver license fee by an additional \$10 for a total cost of \$46.25 per license which would, for every 4-year license issued or renewed, increase receipts by \$10 to the State General Fund to be appropriated for public safety use as required under existing law.

According to ALEA, the cost to implement the provisions of this bill is an estimated \$478,000 for software development, testing, and education of local licensing officials.
