House Bill 55 as passed the House of Representatives would require a one-time expenditure by the State Registrar of Vital Statistics under the Alabama Department of Public Health of an estimated \$75,000 to establish a computer system to issue Certificates of Nonviable Birth. This expense could be offset, wholly or in part, by the collection of a \$15 fee, provided for in this bill, for the issuance of each certificate.
