House Bill 356 as reported by the Committee on Public Safety and Homeland Security would increase the administrative obligations of the Alabama Peace Officers' Standards and Training Commission (APOSTC) to require the implementation of biennial training on interacting with individuals with sensory needs or invisible disabilities, as part of continuing education requirements for law enforcement. This bill would require APOSTC to collaborate with a non-profit company to administer this training and provide it at no-cost to individuals.
