Senate Bill 320 as reported by the Committee on Judiciary could increase the obligations of the Department of Forensic Sciences, paid from the DNA Database Fund, to test and catalog DNA samples taken of illegal aliens in the custody of local law enforcement agencies prior to release from custody. The amount of the Department's increased obligation is undetermined, but would be dependent upon the number of DNA samples that would be required to be tested and cataloged pursuant to the provisions of this bill.

In addition, this bill could increase the administrative obligations of the Alabama Law Enforcement Agency to catalog fingerprints of illegal aliens submitted by local law enforcement agencies.
