## **House Bill 87**

House Bill 87 as passed the House of Representatives could increase the training expenses reimbursed by public entities that hire law enforcement officers, certified corrections officers or firefighters that were previously employed by another public entity within 36 months of the employee's completion of certain required training, instead of within 24 months, as provided by current law. This bill could further increase the obligations of those public entities that hire such trained employees by an undetermined amount dependent on the cost of certain fitted uniform items that may be reimbursed pursuant to this bill. This bill could correspondingly increase training expenses recovered by public entities when such trained employees are hired by other public entities.
