A BILL  
TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

Relating to Butler County; to provide for the salary of the Coroner of Butler County; and to repeal Section 45-7-60 of the Code of Alabama 1975, providing for an expense allowance for the coroner.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1.(a) Effective October 1, 2023, the Coroner of Butler County shall receive a salary in the amount of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) per month to be paid in monthly installments from the county general fund. The salary provided in this section shall be the only compensation of the coroner and shall be in lieu of all other compensation, salary, expenses, or fees of the coroner except as expressly provided in this section. The coroner shall waive any other compensation, expenses, or fees in order to receive the salary provided by this section.

(b) In addition to the salary provided in subsection (a), the Butler County Commission may pay expenses of the coroner related to attending continuing education relating to the performance of the duties of the coroner. In addition, the Butler County Commission may pay for or reimburse the coroner

29 for purchase of supplies specifically related to the  
30 performance of the duties of the coroner.

31 Section 2. All laws or parts of laws in conflict with  
32 this act are repealed. Section 45-7-60 of the Code of Alabama  
33 1975, providing an expense allowance for the coroner, is  
34 repealed.

35 Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately  
36 following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its  
37 otherwise becoming law.
