4 Relating to building codes; to authorize the use of
5 certain refrigerants and refrigerant-equipped products that
6 are in compliance with the National Clean Air Act.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. (a) No provision of the state building code,
9 or any municipal or county building code, or any other law or
10 rule, may prohibit or otherwise limit the use of a substitute
11 refrigerant or substitute refrigerant-equipped product that
12 complies with the National Clean Air Act pursuant to 42 U.S.C.
13 § 7671k and regulations adopted thereunder.

14 (b) Any heating, ventilation, air conditioning, or
15 refrigeration equipment containing a refrigerant described in
16 subsection (a) shall be listed and installed in accordance
17 with all applicable safety standards and use conditions
18 imposed pursuant to the designation.

19 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first
20 day of the third month following its passage and approval by
21 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
