1 Enrolled, An Act,

4 Relating to Houston County; to provide for contracting
5 of police services by a municipality with the Sheriff of
6 Houston County; and to provide for compensation and
7 distribution.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. Any municipality within Houston County may
10 contract for police services with the sheriff of the county.
11 The contract may include the enforcement by the sheriff and
12 his or her duly commissioned deputies of all laws within the
13 corporate limits and police jurisdiction of the municipality,
14 including municipal ordinances, and the arrest or citation of
15 any offenders as if the sheriff and his or her deputies were
16 duly constituted police officers of the municipality.

17 Section 2. A municipality entering into a contract with
18 the sheriff for police services shall pay to the county
19 treasury a sum sufficient to provide the necessary manpower
20 and equipment as mutually agreed upon by the municipal
21 governing body, the sheriff of the county, and the county
22 commission.

23 Section 3. The county governing body may receive from
24 the municipality within the county money for police services
25 and may expend funds for police services in the contracting
26 municipality, including the police jurisdiction of the
27 municipality.

28 Section 4. Each contract between the sheriff and the

29 contracting municipality shall be with the consent and
30 approval of the sheriff and the county commission.

31 Section 5. The sheriff and his or her duly commissioned
32 deputies shall retain the legal and constitutional immunity
33 afforded to each of them by law.

34 Section 6. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
35 with this act are repealed.

36 Section 7. This act shall become effective on the first
37 day of the third month following its passage and approval by
38 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
