SYNOPSIS:

This bill would allow a parent to opt his or her child out of any school policy requiring students to wear a face covering at school, at a school function, on a school bus, or at a school bus stop.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to public K-12 schools, to allow a parent or legal guardian to opt his or her child out of policies requiring a face covering at certain locations.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The parent or guardian of a student at a public K-12 school shall have the right to opt his or her child out of any order or requirement that students wear a face covering at the school, at a school function, on a school bus, or at a school bus stop, by communicating his or her intent to opt out in writing to the school or the local board of education.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
