SYNOPSIS:

Under existing law, termination dates are established for enumerated state agencies. The agencies are periodically reviewed by the Alabama Sunset Committee. After the review process is completed, the committee prepares its recommendations for the agencies to the Legislature in the form of sunset bills which either continue, terminate, or continue with modification each agency reviewed.

This bill would provide for the continuance of the State Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the existence and functioning of the State Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors until October 1, 2027.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the State Board

31 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the State
32 Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land
33 Surveyors, created and functioning pursuant to Sections
34 34-11-1 to 34-11-37, inclusive, Code of Alabama 1975, is
35 continued until October 1, 2027, and those code sections are
36 expressly preserved.

37 Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the
38 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in
39 Sections 1 and 2.

40 Section 4. This act shall become effective immediately
41 upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or upon its
42 otherwise becoming a law.
