SYNOPSIS:

Under existing law, termination dates are established for enumerated state agencies. The agencies are periodically reviewed by the Alabama Sunset Committee. After the review process is completed, the committee prepares its recommendations for the agencies to the Legislature in the form of sunset bills which either continue, terminate, or continue with modification each agency reviewed.

This bill would provide for the continuance of the Board of Examiners on Admission to the State Bar.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the existence and functioning of the Board of Examiners on Admission to the State Bar until October 1, 2027.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Board of Examiners on Admission to the State Bar until October 1, 2027.

29 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the Board
30 of Examiners on Admission to the State Bar, created and
31 functioning pursuant to Section 34-3-2, Code of Alabama 1975,
32 is continued until October 1, 2027, and that code section is
33 expressly preserved.

34 Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the
35 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in
36 Sections 1 and 2.

37 Section 4. This act shall become effective immediately
38 upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or upon its
39 otherwise becoming a law.
