- (b) By the first day of April of each year, every law enforcement agency, as defined in Section 15-5-62, Code of Alabama 1975, shall report all of the following information for the prior calendar year to the Alabama State Law

- 21 (1) The number of new sexual assault cases reported.
- 22 (2) The number of new sexual assault cases reported 23 where evidence from a medical forensic examination was
- 24 submitted for forensic analysis.
- 25 (3) The number of sexual assault cases reported where 26 evidence from a medical forensic examination was not submitted 27 for forensic analysis and the reason it was not submitted.
- 28 (4) The number of sexual assault cases that were closed

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- due to judicial or investigative reasons and the reasons the cases were closed.
