1 Enrolled, An Act,

2

3 Relating to motor vehicle registration and distinctive  
4 motor vehicle license plates; to authorize the issuance of a  
5 distinctive motor vehicle license plate to benefit brain  
6 cancer research.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. This bill shall be known and may be cited as  
9 the Lares-Herring Act.

10 Section 2. (a) Notwithstanding Sections 32-6-64,  
11 32-6-65, 32-6-67, and 32-6-68, upon application to the judge  
12 of probate, license commissioner, or other issuing official,  
13 compliance with motor vehicle registration and licensing laws,  
14 payment of regular fees required by law for license tags or  
15 plates for private passenger or pleasure motor vehicles, and  
16 payment of an additional annual fee of fifty dollars (\$50),  
17 owners of motor vehicles who are residents of Alabama shall be  
18 issued distinctive "Brain Cancer Research" license tags or  
19 plates. These tags or plates shall be valid for five years and  
20 may then be replaced with either conventional, personalized,  
21 or new "Brain Cancer Research" license tags or plates.

22 Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, the license  
23 tags or plates shall only be printed and issued as long as  
24 Blazer Bolt, Incorporated qualifies for a distinctive license  
25 plate category pursuant to Section 32-6-64, for passenger  
26 cars, pickup trucks, and self-propelled campers or house cars.

27 (b) Payment of required license fees and taxes for the  
28 years during which a new tag or plate is not issued shall be

29 evidenced as provided in Section 32-6-63.

30 (c) Blazer Bolt, Incorporated shall be responsible for  
31 the design of the distinctive license plate subject to  
32 approval by the Commissioner of Revenue and compliance with  
33 all laws and rules.

34 (d) The annual fee for the distinctive plates shall be  
35 distributed in accordance with Section 32-6-68. The Blazer  
36 Bolt, Incorporated portion of the fee shall be used to provide  
37 funding for brain cancer research in the State of Alabama.

38 (e) The Department of Revenue may adopt rules to  
39 implement this section.

40 Section 3. This act shall become effective on January  
41 1, 2024, following its passage and approval by the Governor,  
42 or its otherwise becoming law.
