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9	Relating to public records; to add Section 41-13-7.1 to
10	the Code of Alabama 1975, to prohibit the disclosure of
11	personal identifying information of law enforcement officers
12	and employees upon request of the officer or employee; and in
13	connection therewith would have as its purpose or effect the
14	requirement of a new or increased expenditure of local funds
15	within the meaning of Section 111.05 of the Constitution of
16	Alabama of 2022.
17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
18	Section 1. Section 41-13-7.1 is added to the Code of
19	Alabama 1975, to read as follows:
20	§41-13-7.1.
21	(a) For the purposes of this act, the following terms
22	have the following meanings:
23	(1) IDENTIFYING INFORMATION. As defined in Section
24	41-13-7.
25	(2) LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER or EMPLOYEE. A judge of any
26	position, including a judge of a municipal court; a district
27	attorney; a deputy district attorney; an assistant district
28	attorney; an investigator employed by a district attorney; an

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- 29 attorney, investigator, or special agent of the Office of the
- 30 Attorney General; a sheriff; a deputy sheriff; a jailor; or a
- law enforcement officer of a county, municipality, the state,
- 32 or special district, provided the law enforcement officer is
- 33 certified by the Alabama Peace Officers' Standards and
- 34 Training Commission and is not pending decertification; and
- 35 federal officers and employees in equivalent positions.
- 36 (b) Upon the request of a state or federal law
- 37 enforcement officer or employee, a department or agency of the
- 38 state or a county, municipality, or other subdivision of
- 39 government shall redact personal identifying information of
- 40 the officer from any document of the department or agency
- 41 prior to disclosure.
- 42 (c) Each department or agency of the state or a county,
- 43 municipality, or other subdivision of government shall make
- 44 available an online a request form that allows a law
- 45 enforcement officer or employee to request the redaction of
- 46 personal identifying information from the records of the
- 47 department or agency.
- (d) The redaction required by this section shall be
- 49 done on the same terms and conditions as the redaction of the
- records of state and local employees pursuant to Section
- 51 41-13-7.
- 52 Section 2. Although this bill would have as its purpose
- 53 or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of
- local funds, the bill is excluded from further requirements
- and application under Section 111.05 of the Constitution of
- Alabama of 2022, because the bill is determined by the



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Legislative Fiscal Office to have an aggregate insignificant
fiscal impact on affected municipalities, counties,
instrumentalities, or boards.

Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first
day of the third month following its passage and approval by
the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
