A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to Montgomery County; to amend Section 45-51-231 of the Code of Alabama 1975, relating to an expense allowance and salary of the sheriff, to restate the current salary of the sheriff and to delete an expired expense allowance; and to provide a new expense allowance for the sheriff and for the salary of the sheriff if the sheriff has served two or more full consecutive terms as sheriff.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 45-51-231 of the Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§45-51-231

~~(a) The Sheriff of Montgomery County shall receive an expense allowance of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) per year, payable in equal monthly installments from the general fund of the county. This expense allowance shall be in addition to all other compensation or benefits granted to the sheriff and may be treated as compensation for retirement contributions.~~

~~(b) Effective beginning the next term of office,~~

30 language, the annual salary of the Sheriff of Montgomery
31 County shall be one hundred fifty-five thousand dollars

34 Section 2.(a)(1) Any Sheriff of Montgomery County who
35 has served two consecutive full terms shall receive an
36 additional expense allowance of twenty thousand dollars
37 (\$20,000) per year, payable in equal monthly installments from
38 the general fund of the county. This expense allowance shall
39 be in addition to all other compensation or benefits granted
40 to the sheriff and may be treated as compensation for
41 retirement contributions.

42 (2) This subsection shall be void at the end of the
43 current term of the sheriff or on a vacancy in the office of
44 sheriff for any reason.

45 (b) Effective beginning the next term of office of the
46 Sheriff of Montgomery County, and thereafter, any sheriff who
47 has served two or more consecutive full terms as sheriff,
48 shall receive an annual salary in the amount of one hundred
49 seventy-five thousand dollars (\$175,000). The salary shall be
50 paid from the general fund of the county.

51 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first
52 day of the third month following its passage and approval by
53 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
