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1 Enrolled, An Act,

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4 Relating to commissions; to amend Sections 9-14C-2 and
5 9-14C-8, Code of Alabama 1975, to provide for the Red Mountain
6 Greenway and Recreational Area Commission to be renamed the
7 Jefferson County Greenways Commission.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. Sections 9-14C-2 and 9-14C-8, Code of
10 Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:

11 "§9-14C-2

12 (a) There is created the Red Mountain Greenway and
13 Recreational Area Commission to acquire, establish, operate,
14 and maintain as a greenway, recreational and educational area,
15 alternative transportation route, and historic site the land
16 and buildings in Jefferson County along Red Mountain in
17 Birmingham. The purpose of the commission shall be to own,
18 preserve, restore, maintain, and promote as a greenway,
19 recreational area, or historic site the land and relics of the
20 property known as Red Mountain Greenway and Recreational Area,
21 and, in recognition of the important role played by the steel
22 industry in the development of this state, to exhibit this
23 property as an example of the process of mining minerals
24 necessary for the production of steel in this state's early
25 days.

26 (b) The Red Mountain Greenway and Recreational Area
27 Commission as provided for in this chapter shall officially be
28 renamed and called the Jefferson County Greenways Commission.



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29 This section shall in no manner alter the powers, duties,
30 property, personnel, function, or liability of the commission.
31 A reference in any provision of the law to the Red Mountain
32 Greenway and Recreational Area Commission shall be deemed a
33 reference to the Jefferson County Greenways Commission. "

34 "§9-14C-8

35 (a) Employees of the ~~Red Mountain Greenway and~~
36 ~~Recreational Area Commission~~ commission shall not be employees
37 of the state, but shall be treated as state employees for the
38 purpose of participating in any insurance or
39 retirement/pension programs provided for state employees.

40 (b) The ~~Red Mountain Greenway and Recreational Area~~
41 ~~Commission~~ commission may pay the employer's contributions to
42 any insurance or retirement/pension programs out of any funds
43 appropriated or available to the commission for any purpose
44 whatsoever, and the commission may deduct the employee's
45 contributions for the programs by means of payroll deductions
46 or otherwise from any salary or compensation paid employees."

47 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first
48 day of the third month following its passage and approval by
49 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
