

9	Relating to Talladega County; to provide for the
10	operation and management of an inmate commissary at the county
11	jail.
12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
13	Section 1. This act shall be operative only in
14	Talladega County.
15	Section 2. The Sheriff of Talladega County may operate
16	and manage a commissary to sell various items to inmates of
17	the county jail and may use correctional officers to assist in
18	the operation and management of the commissary.
19	Section 3. The sheriff shall maintain a record of all
20	transactions relative to the operation of the commissary for
21	purposes of auditing by the Department of Examiners of Public
22	Accounts.
23	Section 4. All profits from the sale of items through
24	the commissary shall be used by the sheriff to operate and
25	supply the county jail and any legitimate law enforcement
26	purpose at the discretion of the Sheriff of Talladega County.
27	Section 5. This act shall become effective on the first
28	day of the third month following its passage and approval by





the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
