A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to education; to require a public K-12 school, a local board of education, and certain event organizers to accept certain forms of payment for admission to certain school-sponsored events.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) A public K-12 school or a local board of education shall accept cash as a form of payment along with any other form of payment of its choosing for admission to school-sponsored sporting events that are open to the public.

(b) All events that are open to the public, feature at least one team from any public K-12 school, and are held at a public school or university property shall accept cash as a form of payment along with any other form of payment of the event organizer's choosing for admission to the event.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
