1 Enrolled, An Act,

2
3 Relating to Franklin County; to provide for the annual
4 expense allowance and salary and other benefits for the
5 coroner; and to further authorize the Franklin County
6 Commission to appropriate and expend funds for the operation
7 of the office of the coroner.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. (a) Effective October 1, 2023, the Coroner
10 of Franklin County shall receive an expense allowance in the
11 amount of nine thousand seven hundred dollars (\$9,700) per
12 annum, which shall be in addition to all other expense
13 allowances, compensation, or salary provided by law. The
14 expense allowance shall be paid in equal monthly installments
15 from the general fund of the county.

16 (b) Effective for the term of office beginning after
17 the 2026 General Election, the expense allowance provided for
18 in subsection (a) shall be null and void and the Coroner of
19 Franklin County shall receive an annual salary of ten thousand
20 dollars (\$10,000), to be paid in equal monthly installments
21 from the general fund of the county. The salary in this
22 subsection shall be the total compensation paid to the
23 coroner, subject to the adjustments provided in subsection
24 (c).

25 (c) In addition to the salary provided in subsection
26 (b), the salary of the coroner shall be increased by any
27 uniform increases in compensation granted equally to all
28 county employees by the Franklin County Commission. In

29 addition, the coroner may participate in the county health
30 insurance plan and any retirement plan provided to county
31 employees under the same terms as county employees.

32 (d) The Franklin County Commission may appropriate and
33 expend county funds for the coroner's salary, benefits, and
34 expenses necessary for the operation of the office of the
35 coroner. The commission may provide the coroner with expenses
36 for the operation of a motor vehicle or may furnish the
37 coroner with the use of a county vehicle.

38 (e) The Franklin County Commission may authorize the
39 coroner to appoint one or more deputy coroners to perform the
40 duties of the coroner in the absence of the coroner and
41 provide for the compensation of any deputy coroner appointed.

42 Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
43 with this act are repealed. Act 1185, 1969 Regular Session
44 (Acts 1969, p. 2213), as amended by Act 90-461, 1990 Regular
45 Session (Acts 1990, p. 653); Act 491, 1971 Regular Session
46 (Acts 1971, p. 1205); and Act 446, 1973 Regular Session (Acts
47 1973, p. 636), are expressly repealed.

48 Section 3. This act shall become effective on October
49 1, 2023, following its passage and approval by the Governor,
50 or its otherwise becoming law.
