5	TO BE ENTITLED
6	AN ACT
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9	Relating to Talladega County; to amend Sections 1 and 3
10	of Act 91-522 of the 1991 Regular Session (Acts 1991, p. 923),
11	as amended by Act 2018-101 of the 2018 Regular Session, to
12	further provide for the employment and duties of the county
13	engineer; and to repeal Section 2 of Act 91-522, providing for
14	nominations to fill the position by the state highway
15	director.
16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
17	Section 1. Sections 1 and 3 of Act 91-522 of the 1991
18	Regular Session (Acts 1991, p. 923), as amended, are amended
19	to read as follows:
20	"Section 1. The Talladega County Commission shall
21	employ, supervise, and direct a county engineer who shall be a
22	thoroughly qualified and competent civil engineer possessing
23	all of the qualifications as specified for county engineers
24	under the general laws of the State of Alabama, who shall
25	devote his or her entire time and attention to the maintenance
26	and construction of the Talladega County public roads,
27	highways, and bridges, and ferries; and who shall reside in
28	Talladega County during his or her employment. Notwithstanding

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29 the foregoing, the Talladega County Commission may waive the 30 requirement that the county engineer reside in the county by a 31 majority vote of the county commission.

32 "Section 3. Subject to the approval and direction of 33 the county commission, It shall be the duty of the county 34 engineer τ shall perform those the duties prescribed provided 35 for in Section 11-6-3, Code of Alabama 1975, and a) to employ, 36 supervise and direct all such assistants as are necessary to 37 maintain and construct the public roads, highways, bridges and ferries of the county, to have authority to prescribe their 38 duties, and to discharge said employees for cause or when no 39 needed; b) to perform such engineering and surveying service 40 as may be required and to prepare and maintain the necessary 41 42 maps and records; c) to maintain the necessary accounting 43 records to reflect the cost of the county highway system; d) to build, construct new roads or change old roads, but only 44 45 when order to do so by proper order to do so by proper order 46 of the county commission; and e) to shall construct and 47 maintain all paved and unpaved county roads on the basis of 48 the county as a unit without regard to any district or beat 49 lines."

50 Section 2. Section 2 of Act 91-522, providing for 51 nominations to fill the position of county engineer by the 52 state highway director, is repealed.

53 Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately 54 following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its 55 otherwise becoming law.
