1 Enrolled, An Act, 2 3 4 Relating to Houston County; to amend Section 45-35-111, 5 Code of Alabama 1975, to provide for the compensation and appointment of election officials; and to repeal Section 6 45-35-111.01, Code of Alabama 1975. 7 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 9 Section 1. Section 45-35-111, Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows: 10 11 **"**§45-35-111 (a) (1) In Houston County, the election officials who 12 13 work at polling places are hereby entitled to an additional per diem allowance in such an amount as will, together with 14 15 any amount paid by the state, make the total paid to such officials fifty-five dollars (\$55) for each day they work at 16 the polls and supervisors are hereby entitled to an additional 17 18 per diem allowance in such amount as will, together with any amount paid by the state, make the total paid to them 19 20 sixty-five dollars (\$65) for each day they work at the 21 polls. referred to in Section 17-8-12 as "inspectors" and 22 "clerks" are respectively referred to as "chief inspectors" 23 and "poll workers." 24 (2) The Houston County Appointing Board may appoint 25 chief inspectors and deputy chief inspectors from the total 26 number of appointed poll workers. (b) A chief inspector shall receive additional 27 28 compensation in an amount that, together with any amount paid

by the state, shall make his or her total compensation two
hundred dollars (\$200) per day for each day he or she works at
the polls.

- (c) A deputy chief inspector shall receive additional compensation in an amount that, together with any amount paid by the state, shall make his or her total compensation one hundred fifty dollars (\$150) per day for each day he or she works at the polls.
- (d) Poll workers shall receive additional compensation in an amount that, together with any amount paid by the state, shall make their total compensation one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125) per day for each day they work at the polls.
- (e) If the amount paid to such the above officials as compensation or expense allowance by the state increases in the future, then the amount paid by the county under this section shall automatically decrease in a like amount.
- (f) The expense allowance All additional compensation provided for in this section shall be paid from the general fund of the county."
- Section 2. Section 45-35-111.01, Code of Alabama 1975, providing for additional compensation for Houston County poll workers, is repealed.
- Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
