24	its agent, may donate and deliver up to 4.5 liters or
25	equivalent thereof of liquor sourced from a licensed
26	manufacturer or importer to a licensed nonprofit special event
27	operated by or on behalf of a nonprofit organization for each

29	federal laws, rules, and regulations. Donations shall be
30	reported on a form prescribed by the board. Donations shall be
31	taxed on a sales price imputed by the board based upon the
32	listed retail price of the product donated. Any liquor
33	remaining at the conclusion of the nonprofit event shall be
34	returned to the broker for disposal.
35	Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first
36	day of the third month following its passage and approval by
37	the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
