WHEREAS, highest commendations are herein proudly 8 conveyed to Coach William Earl Griffin for being inducted 9 into the Alabama High School Sports Hall of Fame; and 10 11 WHEREAS, Coach Griffin is a native of Clanton, 12 Alabama, and a 1960 graduate of Verbena High School; during 13 his high school years, he excelled in all sports and earned All County honors in baseball, football, and basketball; he 14 15 also excelled in Babe Ruth Baseball and American Legion 16 Baseball; upon high school graduation, Major League Baseball 17 Scout, Dixie Walker, offered him a \$1,000 signing bonus to play for the Milwaukee Braves, but he decided to attend 18 19 college instead; Coach Griffin earned a Bachelor's Degree from Auburn University in 1964 and a Master's Degree in 20 21 Administration from The University of Montevallo; and 22 WHEREAS, from 1964 until his retirement in 2000, Coach Griffin was labeled by some as Mr. Dallas County High 23 School; he began his career at Dallas County High School in 24 25 1964 as a math and physical education teacher while also

28	winning seasons in seven years, had nine All-State players,
29	had an overall record of 91-39-6, and had a region record of
30	16-5; he received numerous Coach of the Year honors for his

33	achievements during his coaching career include winning the
34	Alabama High School Athletic Association Class 1A/2A State
35	Baseball Championship in 1970; making the Alabama High
36	School Athletic Association Class 3A State Baseball
37	Semifinals in 1975 and 1976; having the baseball field and
38	field house named in his honor; and serving as an official
39	with the Central Alabama Football Officials Association, the
