14 Golden Eagles Boys Varsity Basketball Team has victoriously  
15 achieved one accomplishment after another during the

19 Athletic Association Class 4A Boys Basketball State

24 selected as Area Most Valuable Player, two members selected  
25 to the Northeast Regional Tournament Team and one member

26 selected as Northeast Regional Tournament Most Valuable  
27 Player, two members selected to the Northeast Regional  
28 Tournament Team and one member selected Most Valuable Player  
29 of the State Tournament, and one member selected for the  
30 Alabama/Mississippi All-Star Game; and

31 WHEREAS, the members of the Jacksonville High School  
32 Golden Eagles Boys Varsity Basketball Team's other  
33 achievements during the 2022-2023 season include being  
34 recognized as number five in the Power 10 Boys Teams in the  
35 State; having wins against the number one and number six  
36 teams in Class 4A, number eight in Class 5A, number 6 in  
37 Class 3A, as well as the current Class 6A State Champion and  
38 Class 3A State Champion; starting the season 1-3 and ending  
39 the season on a 10-game win streak; averaging 71.3 points  
40 per game; outscoring opponents 2,495 points to 1,814 points;  
41 shooting 36 percent three-pointers compared to opponent's 30  
42 percent; scoring over 80 points in 13 games; averaging 77.9  
43 points per game while holding out opponents to under 50  
44 (45.7) points per game during the post season play's last  
45 seven games; and being named Class 4A Area 10 Champions  
46 during the regular season and tournament, Northeast Regional  
47 Tournament Champions, and Class 4A State Champions; and
