STEPHEN LAMAR FAULK FOR OVER 5 30 YEARS OF SERVICE IN PASTORAL MINISTRY AND FOR OVER 26 6 YEARS OF SERVICE IN THE FIELD OF EDUCATION. 7 WHEREAS, with great pride and special pleasure, we 8 highly honor Reverend Dr. Stephen Lamar Faulk for over 30 9 years of service in pastoral ministry and for over 26 years 10 11 of service in the field of education; and 12 WHEREAS, a native of Union Springs, Alabama, Reverend 13 Dr. Faulk was born into a devout Christian family and knew 14 early in life what path God was preparing for him; his passion for learning and teaching began as a child, and he 15 16 was an excellent student in school, church, and the 17 community; his calling to serve the church also began at a 18 young age, as his Christian walk was nurtured at Cornerstone 19 AME Zion Church and throughout the Alabama Conference at the 20 churches where his father pastored; at only 14 years of age, 21 Reverend Dr. Faulk became the youngest District Secretary 22 for the Greater Union Springs District; later, he became the National Christian Youth Council President for the Greater 23 Union Springs District and the Alabama Conference; and 24 25 WHEREAS, Reverend Dr. Faulk served in the capacities

of teacher, Assistant Principal, Principal, and District
Administrator for several schools over a span of more than
26 years; served as an Educational Consultant for Alabama
State University and Auburn University; and served as a
faculty mentor for doctoral students at Hood Theological
Seminary in Salisbury, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Dr. Faulk received his Local 32 Preacher's License on June 13, 1989, before delivering his 33 Trial Sermon; was admitted into the Alabama Conference on 34 35 Trial and received Traveling Preacher's Licenses on October 36 29, 1989; was ordained a Deacon on October 28, 1990; was ordained an Elder on February 2, 1992; and served as Pastor 37 38 for numerous churches in the Alabama Conference, including 39 Auburn AME Zion Church, where he has been diligently serving since 2002; and 40

41 WHEREAS, Reverend Dr. Faulk has received many awards 42 and accolades over the years, including, but not limited to, 43 being selected as Teacher of the Week by the Montgomery Advertiser, Teacher of the Year by McIntyre Junior High 44 45 School, Renaissance Leader by the Alabama State Department 46 of Education, Principal of the Year by the Class of 2013 at Loachapoka High School, and Presiding Elder of the Year for 47 the Alabama-Florida Episcopal District of the AME Zion 48 Church; and receiving the Keys to the Cities of Tuskegee and 49 Union Springs, the Roosevelt L. Thompson Memorial Award, and 50
