32 at the young age of four and has never let the condition
33 stop him from working hard, helping others, and enjoying his
34 interests; when he was 10, his father was diagnosed with
35 renal failure and placed on dialysis; Jacori remained
36 positive and prayed for his father to receive a kidney; he
37 stepped up and did more work to make life easier for his
38 father and to keep the household running; a few years later,
39 his father received a kidney; and

40 WHEREAS, Jacori is a shining light in his studies,
41 with his family, and in his community; he diligently
42 maintains his grades and is always ready to assist those in
43 need; for his commitment to academics, family, and community
44 service, he has been recognized by Alabama Public Television
45 as one of its five Young Heroes of Alabama for 2023; now
