9	Walter E. Penry, Jr., who passed away on March 30, 2023,

27	Water System, where he helped bring water system service to
28	rural portions of Baldwin County that had only had well
29	water previously; and
30	WHEREAS, Mr. Penry began his first term in the
31	Alabama House of Representatives in 1979 and created a
32	legacy of active service and advocacy for his district and
33	region that included creating legislation that established
34	Blakeley State Park and allowed citizens to vote on the
35	expansion of nearby municipal limits, and he fought to make
36	sure that Baldwin County and Mobile County were able to keep
37	a larger portion of oil and gas revenue generated from their
38	area, as well as statewide legislation that protected
39	medical workers doing pro-bono work by providing liability
40	insurance for them through the State of Alabama; and
41	WHEREAS, Mr. Penry is survived by his wife of 70
42	years, Jane Mathews Penry; daughter, Dr. S. Elizabeth Penry;
43	sons, Walter E. Penry III, Charles D. Penry (Lane), and John
44	W. Penry (Beth Dietz); and grandchildren, Evan Penry,
45	William Penry, Grace Penry, Aiden Penry, Sarah Penry, and
