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Replace line 12 on page 1 with the following:
underserved counties in the state; to require certain
reporting to the Legislature; and to provide a
termination date.

After line 200 on page 8 insert the following:

(h) (1) Prior to the certification of any
clinical preceptorship, the Alabama Statewide Area
Health Education Center Program Office shall conduct a
needs assessment of the current number and current
need for preceptors in the state and submit a final
report of the assessment to the Governor, Lieutenant
Governor, Speaker of the House of Representatives,
President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Chairs of the
House and Senate Health Committees, and the Chairs of
the Senate Finance and Taxation Education and the
House Ways and Means Education Committees.

(2) Annually, on or before the first day of
December, the Alabama Statewide Area Health Education



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24 Center Program Office shall report on the condition,
25 performance, and accomplishments of the program to the
26 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Speaker of the House of
27 Representatives, President Pro Tempore of the Senate,
28 the Chairs of the of the House and Senate Health
29 Committees, and the Chairs of the Senate Finance and
30 Taxation Education and the House Ways and Means
31 Education Committees.

32 (3) The Alabama Statewide Area Health Education
33 Center Program Office shall consult with the Alabama
34 Commission on the Evaluation of Services to develop
35 performance metrics and other measures of success to
36 include in the annual report required pursuant to
37 subdivision (2). During the fiscal year 2030, the
38 program shall undergo an evaluation by the Alabama
39 Commission on the Evaluation of Services to determine
40 whether the program is impacting the determined
41 measures of success.
